Delay of Non-Essential Operations - City of Coleman

Due to inclement weather, most City of Coleman facilities will delay operations until 10:00 AM on Wednesday, February 5, 2020. A winter weather event is affecting the City of Coleman. The National Weather Service has issued Winter Weather Advisory for our area to include sleet, freezing rain, and snow. These conditions are expected to continue through Wednesday afternoon.

- Public Library

Waste Connections of Texas may have a delay in Garbage Collections. Please leave your trash receptacles out and Waste Connections will resume operations as soon as the weather permits.

Public Safety Facilities will continue to serve our residents.

A Winter Weather Advisory means that periods of snow, sleet, or freezing rain will cause travel difficulties. Be prepared for slippery roads and limited visibilities.
