Citizens asked to conserve water on Tuesday, December 22, 2020 from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm

The City of Coleman is in the process of transferring the main water line into the new Water Treatment Plant. This transfer will take place on <u>*Tuesday, December*</u> <u>22, 2020 from 7:00 am until 2:00 pm</u>. As a part of the process, The City of Coleman is urging residents to <u>conserve water during that time</u>.

To maintain adequate water supply and pressure, Residents are asked to NOT use unnecessary water. Minimizing usage will reduce the potential for the water system to loose pressure. The city is topping off all tanks in town to ensure water service for essential needs will not be disrupted during the transfer.

Please do your part and refrain from:

- Letting faucets run while washing dishes, bathing, or brushing teeth
- Running dishwashers
- Washing loads of laundry
- Flushing toilets unnecessarily
- Watering plants and lawns

Doing your part will help ensure a smooth transition of services.
