City Offices Closed on Friday, February 4th, 2022

City Facilities will remain closed to the public on Friday, February 4th, 2022.

The National Weather Service has advised that road conditions are expected to remain hazardous through Friday due to widespread ice and snowpack. Although some partial melting has taken place, this is expected to re-freeze on the roads after sunset. Even some spots that may appear to be clear will likely have black ice. Road conditions will therefore become very icy and slippery overnight and through Friday morning and possibly into Saturday. Non-essential travel is being discouraged.

Waste Connections of Texas will has advised us that they will be unable to run their planned route on Friday. Please see the schedule below for your pickup information.

Thursday service (2/3/2022) will be picked up on <u>Saturday</u>. Friday service (2/4/2022) will be picked up as soon as possible. Please leave your container at the curb.
