

Proposition F

An amendment to the City Charter prohibiting a member of the City Council, the Chief of Police, member of any board, appointive officer or an employee, from holding other public offices when prohibited by law.

Section 2.03 Prohibiting Holding or Running for Other Office.

No person elected to the City Council, or as Chief of Police, shall, during the term for which elected, be appointed to any office or position in the service of the City when holding those offices concurrently would be prohibited by law. A member of the City Council, the Chief of Police, or a member of any board appointed by the City Council, or any appointive officer or employee of the City who becomes a candidate for nomination or election to any publicly elected office other than re-election to the same position on the City Council or Chief of Police, where the holding of those offices are prohibited by law, shall forfeit that ~~place~~ office or position with the City effective upon election to such office.
