OLD BUSINESS:

1. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1176 to approve the Budget for FY 2017-2018 – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilwoman Hetzel to approve the second reading of Ordinance 1176 approving the Budget for FY 2017-2018. Councilman McGee seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
2. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1177 to increase Water Rates beginning October 1, 2017 – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilman McGee to approve the seconded reading of Ordinance No 1177 increasing the water rates beginning October 1, 2017. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
3. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1178 to increase Sewer Rates to become effective on October 1, 2017 – Mayor, Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilman Smith to approve the seconded reading of Ordinance 1178 increasing sewer rates to become effective on October 1, 2017. Mayor Pro Tem Jameson seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
4. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1179 adding a surcharge to the City Utility bills to pay for road improvements within the City of Coleman to become effective on October 1, 2017 – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Councilwoman Hetzel to approve the second reading of Ordinance 1179 adding a surcharge to the City utility bills to pay for road improvements. Councilman McGee seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
5. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take action to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1180 to increase permit fees as well as other related City fees and cost to become effective on October 1, 2017 – Mayor Tommy Sloan. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jameson to approve the second reading of Ordinance 1180 to increase permit fees as well as other related City fees. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
6. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1182 approving a design manual for the installation of network nodes and node support poles – Mayor Tommy Sloan and City Attorney Pat Chesser. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jameson to approve Ordinance 1182 as amended by changing the language on Page 10, paragraph F of the Design Manual to communications lines and deleting references to electrical lines. Councilwoman Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
7. The City Council may consider, discuss and or take actions to approve the second reading of Ordinance No 1183 regulating the physical use, occupancy and maintenance of City rights-of-way by wireless network providers – Mayor Tommy Sloan and City Attorney Pat Chesser. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Jameson to approve Ordinance No 1183 as amended by increasing the application fees for each network node to \$500.00 for up to five nodes, \$250.00 for each additional node, and \$1,000.00 for each network node support pole. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
