Present: *Mayor Tommy Sloan, Mayor Pro Tem Sharlene Taylor Hetzel, Councilmember Tracy Rankin, Councilmember Bobby McGee, Councilmember Monte Sides, City Attorney Pat Chesser, and Assistant City Manager James King.*

Absent: *City Manager Diana Lopez*

1. Call to Order, Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance: *Mayor Tommy Sloan called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Councilmember Sides gave the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flags of the United States and State of Texas followed.*
2. Introductions, Announcements, and Recognitions: *ACM King advised the Council that City Manager Lopez regretted being unable to attend the meeting but was in Austin for required travel.*
3. Items to be withdrawn: *None.*
4. Citizen Presentations: *None.*
5. Consider, and act upon the approval of minutes for the City of Coleman Council Meeting held on February 17, 2022. *A motion was made by Councilmember Sides to approve the minutes as presented. Councilmember McGee seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*
6. Hear presentation from the Coleman Police Department regarding the 2021 Racial Profiling Data Report. *Interim Chief Bratton presented the 2021 Racial Profiling Data to the Council. No action was taken by the Council.*
7. Discuss, consider, and act upon a Resolution ordering the cancellation of the General Election scheduled for May 7, 2022, declaring unopposed candidates for Place 1 and Place 4, and declaring them elected to office. *ACM King advised the Council that the filing period for the General Election called for May 7, 2022, had expired and that there was only one candidate who had filed for each position. A Certification of Unopposed Candidates had been filed showing Tracy Rankin as the only candidate for Place 1, North Ward, and Monte Sides as the only candidate for Place 4, South Ward. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel to approve the resolution. Councilmember McGee seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*
8. Hear status update from the Assistant City Manager regarding the following projects: Water Plant. *ACM King gave an update on the status of the Water Treatment Plant which received Conditional Approval from TCEQ on February 25<sup>th</sup>. The plant began producing treated water on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Additional testing and reporting will be required over the next year due to the change in type of treatment facility.*
9. Adjournment *A motion was made by Councilmember Sides to adjourn the meeting at 5:27 p.m. Councilmember Rankin seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*
