


MINUTES

Consider and act upon setting the time and place of a public hearing on the tax rate for the City of Coleman Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget and causing publication of notice of public hearing. *A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel to schedule a public hearing on the tax rate for September 1st, at 5:15 p.m., during the regularly scheduled council meeting. Councilmember Rankin seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*

Consider and act upon fixing dates and times of budget workshops for the Proposed Fiscal Year 2022-2023 City of Coleman Budget, if needed. *A motion was made by Councilmember Rankin to schedule a budget workshop for August 18th at 5:15 p.m., during the regularly scheduled council meeting. Councilmember Sides seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*
