1. Call to Order, Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance: *Mayor Tommy Sloan called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. and gave the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flags of the United States and State of Texas followed.*
2. Introductions, Announcements, and Recognitions: *None.*
3. Items to be withdrawn: *None.*
4. Citizen Presentations: *None.*
5. Consider, and act upon the approval of minutes for the City of Coleman Council Meetings held on August 18, 2022. *A motion was made by Councilmember Rankin to approve the minutes as presented. Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.*
6. Consider, discuss, and act upon selection of a candidate for the ballot for the 2022 Board of Trustees election for the Region 6 TML Health Benefits Pool Board of Trustee Election. *A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel to cast a ballot for Stephen Haynes as the Region 6 Trustee for TML Health Benefits Pool. Councilmember Rankin seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.*
7. The Council will conduct a public hearing on the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. *The Public Hearing was opened at 5:22 p.m. CM Lopez presented updated information on the proposed budget to Council. There were no public comments. The Public Hearing closed at 5:27 p.m.*
8. Following the Public Hearing on the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Proposed Budget, the City Council shall take action on the budget, either in the form of approval or a vote to postpone the final budget vote. *A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel to postpone the final budget vote until the meeting on September 8, 2022. Councilmember Rankin seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.*
9. The Council will conduct a public hearing on the proposed tax rate of \$0.460006 per \$100 of valuation for Tax Year 2022. *The Public Hearing was opened at 5:29 p.m. CM Lopez presented updated information on the proposed tax rate to Council. There were no public comments. The Public Hearing closed at 5:35 p.m.*
10. Following the Public Hearing on the proposed tax rate for Tax Year 2022, the City Council shall announce the date, time and place of the meeting at which it will vote on the tax rate. *A motion was made by Councilmember Rankin to set a meeting for Thursday, September 8th, 2022, at 5:15 p.m. to vote on the tax rate. Mayor Pro Tem Hetzel seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.*
