1. Call to Order, Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance: *Mayor Tommy Sloan called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem Sharlene Hetzel gave the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance to the flags of the United States and State of Texas followed.*
2. Introductions, Announcements, and Recognitions: *City Manager Diana Lopez spoke, gave Council members an update on the new street signs being installed.*

5. Consider, and act upon the approval of minutes for the City of Coleman Council Meetings held on November 3, 2022. *A motion was made by Councilmember Sides to approve the minutes as presented. Councilmember Brudney seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.*

Discuss, consider, and act upon a) a Memorandum of Understanding between the Coleman Police Department and Coleman Community Watch Citizens Patrol and b) a Memorandum of Citizens Patrol for the purpose of achieving the various aims and objectives relating to Community Emergency Services Assistance Projects and authorizing the Fire Chief and Chief of Police to execute the memorandums. *Mr. Turner presented an outline of the program to council, Fire Chief Jimmy Watson, Police Chief Marty Baker and City Manager Diana Lopez spoke regarding the program. A Motion was made by Councilmember Charlene Hetzel to approve the execution of a Memorandum between the Coleman Fire Department and Coleman Police Department with Randy Turner, of the Coleman Community Watch Citizens Patrol. The Motion was seconded by Council Member Rankin. The motion carried 5-0.*
7. The City Council entered into Executive Session to discuss the following pursuant to:
  - A. Government Code §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), §551.076 (Deliberations regarding security devices or security audits) the City Council may discuss the safety, security, and public uses of Lake Scarborough.
