

NOTICE OF PUBLICATION

Section 2.14 of the City Charter requires that the City of Coleman publish the descriptive caption of any ordinance which is passed AND which contains any penalty, fine or forfeiture for any violations of any provisions of the ordinance. The City of Coleman recently passed a new ordinance regarding reduction of speed limit which does include provisions for penalties or fines for failures to comply with the provisions outlined within the Ordinance. The following descriptive caption is therefore being printed in the Coleman Chronicle and Democratic Voice on April 17, 2019 to fulfill the charter requirements. This Ordinance will become effective after this publication in the Coleman newspaper. The descriptive caption reads as follows:

An Ordinance establishing a speed limit of 45 mph from mile point 0.000 to mile point 0.630 on FM 1274 and a speed limit of 60 MPH from mile point 0.630 to mile point 2.488 on FM 1274; providing a penalty not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for conviction of any violation thereof; providing a severability clause; providing a savings clause; and setting an effective date.

The effective date of this Ordinance will therefore be **April 18, 2019**. For additional information, the Citizens of Coleman may contact Karen Langley, City Secretary of the City of Coleman.
